

## **CURRICULUM**

The school now follows the CBSE pattern and syllabus. It also teaches the state language Odia and the National Language Hindi.

Talent development programmes:

The school is a house which gives growth to the small little talents. The students are provided with computer education from class I. We have introduced Karate, Music and dance classes as co-curricular activities.

The students are provided with the basic knowledge about the importance of physical exercise and yoga meditation. They together with their studies are instructed with regard to the social health. To respect their parents and elders to protect and take good care of the nature and other good habits that make a person healthy and respectable.

We have two school buses to provide transportation facility.

To make students physically fit and for their all-round development we are having facilities for different types sports and games like Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Badminton, Cricket, Football, Volley Ball etc..

To improve the skills of the students, the school introduced skilled subjects like food preservation, weaving, mask making, Artificial intelligence and so on.

With a view to develop their intellect and aptitude for various activities the school organises various competitions like School Exhibition, speech debate essay singing drawing & painting and acting etc.

The school provides fees concession to deserving students and free education to those who are very poor as per the governments Right to Education policy. The school has been granted No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the government on 28.07.2023.
